The Trauma Counselling Program for Women offers Longer-Term Individual Counselling, Short-Term Individual Crisis Counselling, and Group Counselling for women who have experienced childhood abuse/neglect, sexual assault, and/or intimate partner violence living South Surrey, White Rock, and surrounding areas. Counsellors work within a feminist-informed, trauma-specific framework. Funded by the Ministry of Housing & Social Development, Stopping the Violence Branch. Public awareness education presentations are also available for laypersons and professionals.

Immediate Short-Term Crisis counselling is for women who have experienced a physical assault by an intimate partner or a sexual assault within the previous six month. Longer-Term Counselling is for women who want to work on issues directly arising from the abuse/violence trauma they have experienced.

- Big Brother/Big Sister Program

Adult volunteer is matched one-on-one to child in need of a positive role model. Volunteer spends 3-4 hours per week sharing activities and developing a friendship. Children are predominantly from single parent families. Boys are from father-absent homes. Serves Langley, Fort Langley, Aldergrove and Walnut Grove.

- In-School Mentoring Program


Adult volunteer is matched one-to-one to child in grades 2, 3 or 4 during the school year only. Volunteer spends 1 hour per week in school setting (out of classroom) building friendship, confidence, self esteem etc. through shared activities. This is not a tutoring program. Serves Langley, Aldergrove, Walnut Grove and Fort Langley.
